What is Bocce?



- Bocce originated in Italy in the early 20th century
- It’s a fun game, that’s easy to play
- Anyone can play, as it requires minimal effort
- You simply roll a bocce ball (see picture on left) towards a smaller white ball called a ‘pallina’
- The player that gets their bocce ball(s) closer to the pallina than their opponent, wins the shot(s)
- It is a great game that can be played both socially or competitively
